QUESTION 3

Adam works as the IBM Web Content Manager administrator within the Finance department. One of the authoring templates within his library is called Results. Within this authoring template, his content authors enter how many products, such as teddy bears, have been purchased. Currently all fields within this authoring template have been created as text fields.

How can Adam ensure that his content authors enter whole numbers?

- A. Adam must change the fields within the Results authoring template from Text to Number.
- B. Adam must change the fields within the Results authoring template from Text to Currency.

C. Adam must change the fields within the Results authoring template from Text to Currency. Within the field properties, he should set the minimum and maximum values.

D. Adam must change the fields within the Results authoring template from Text to Numbers. Within the field properties, he should select the Whole Numbers Only radio button.

QUESTION 4

QUESTION 5

Graham is a content developer. He has been tasked to create several forms for the Internet site for his company. He does not want to have to create a presentation template for every page that requires a form. How could he reduce the number of presentation templates needed to display the various forms for his Internet site?

A. Within his authoring templates, Graham could place a Text field. He could then select the HTML forms needed within the text field.

B. Within his authoring templates, Graham could place an Option Selection field. Then, he could create the HTML forms as separate HTML objects and reference them with the Option Selection fields of his content item.

QUESTION 8

Sam is an IBM Web Content Manager administrator. He has created a few web content pages with the Web Content Manager Viewer portlet in them. Most of the users can customize the settings for specific pages using the Edit Shared Settings section.

What must Sam do to restrict some of these parameters from being changed?

- A. Click Configure on the portlet menu. For the setting that he wants to lock, click the lock icon next to the label for the setting.
- B. Click Configure on the portlet menu. For the setting that he wants to lock, click the Personalize icon next to the label for the setting.
- C. Click Configure on the portlet menu. For the setting that he wants to lock, clear the Allow Customize check box next to the label for the setting.
- D. A specific setting cannot be locked. Instead, he can restrict access permission for the portlet and not provide an option to access Edit Shared Settings or Personalize.

QUESTION 9

What task can he execute to apply inherited access permissions and remove existing item access permissions for all items?
